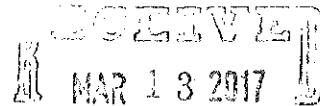
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 10723(b) of the California Water Code and Section 6066 of the California Government Code that the Board of Directors of Cabazon Water District (CWD) will hold a public hearing to consider approving a memorandum of agreement (MOA) with the City of Banning, Banning Heights Mutual Water Company, and San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency approving the establishment of the San Gorgonio Pass Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA). If the governing boards of CWD and the other public entities approve the MOA, the GSA will be authorized to be formed over a designated portion of the San Gorgonio Pass Subbasin of the Coachella Valley Groundwater Basin (the Subbasin). The MOA will also include Mission Springs Water District and Desert Water Agency as parties because those agencies have established or intend to establish separate groundwater sustainability agencies in the eastern portion of the Subbasin with whom the GSA will coordinate. The meeting of CWD to consider approving the MOA will take place on March 21, 2017 at 6:00 p.m., in the Boardroom of its headquarters, located at 14618 Broadway St., Cabazon, CA 92230.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to hear and receive comments from the public regarding CWD's proposed approval of the MOA.

The draft MOA and related documentation are on file with the Secretary to the Board of Directors of CWD and are available for inspection during regular business hours at the office of the CWD at 14618 Broadway St., Cabazon, CA 92230.
